World Health Day celebration (04 April 2023)





Liver Transplant: Kerala doctor's research garners international attention

Dr. FADL H VEERANKUTTY, Consultant in the department of liver transplantation at Lisie Hospital, Cochin made a notable research presentation in the annual conference of international liver Transplantation society (ILTS) which was held in Rotterdam, Netherlands (May 3-6). He was invited by conference secretariat to present his research comparing robotic donor hepatectomy and open donor hepatectomy in the session of 'advances in liver surgery'. His study found that compared to open donor hepatectomy, robotic donor surgery significantly reduces inflammatory response to surgical stress. This may enhance the recovery of donors leading to early discharge from the hospital. Dr Fadl also had given a talk in the previous year's ILTS conference which was held at Istanbul, Turkey. He presented there an innovative technique



of liver transplantation which can be used to treat COVID-19 related liver disease. Later, he published this technique in the American journal of transplantation. Doctors at Lisie hospital performed 22 liver transplants in last year.



Wernicke's Encephalopathy with Incidental Pituitary Haemorrhage in Hyperemesis Gravidarum

Sir,
Wernicke's Encephalopathy (WE) is due to deficiency of thiamine. It is seen in situations of nutritional deficiency like chronic alcoholism, hyperemesis of pregnancy, systemic malignancy, bariatric surgery, haemodialysis, prolonged intravenous feeding, refeeding, and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome. Approximately, 80% of patients with untreated WE develop Korsakoff syndrome, characterized by memory impairment and confabulation.^[1] We describe a case of WE with incidental pituitary haemorrhage in a patient with hyperemesis gravidarum.




Figure 1: (a) Right fundus, superficial haemorrhage along the inferior

acuity was 0/36 in both eyes, she could count the number of letters better than 1 mm apart, as she could not see them to identify them. She had no pupillary light reflex, but had pupillary and deep tendon reflexes in all limbs. Finger-to-nose finger coordination was normal but was severely ataxic on standing and walking. Anatomical localization considered were 1) upbeat nystagmus due to lesions of projections from anterior commissary nucleus to pretectal area; 2) superior rectus and inferior oblique palsies, in a hemispatial (ipsilateral region) and 3) gaze ataxia due to a lesion of cerebellar vermis or its connections. Differentials were 1) posterior circulation stroke, 2) brainstem demyelination lesion, 3) mass lesion with acute hemorrhage, 4) nutritional thiamine deficiency, and 5) drug or toxin ingestion.

Lab studies revealed elevated 12.9 g/dL^a, normal serum glucose, and normal serum lactate levels. SGPT 22 U/L, SGOT 22 U/L, serum total protein 5.7 g/dL, albumin 2.5 g/dL, globulins 2.5 g/dL, INR test 12.4 sec, control 3.8 sec. APTT test 26.9 sec, and control 28 sec. Ultrasound of the abdomen showed distended gallbladder with calculi and evidence of cholecystitis.






