The certificate recognizes Lisie Hospital's Compliance to the highest quality and safety parameters for patients and health care workers in its operation theaters. It is also a testament of its Stringent adherence to environment friendly and safe operation theaters.

The certificate offered by Bureau Veritas, a global leader in testing, inspection and certificate in association with Abbott, E-multi hospital stake holder. In a function conducted at hospital on 05. 07. 2016 Director, Rev. Fr. Thomas Vaikathuparambil received the certificate from Mr. Charli Cherrampilly, lead auditor Bureau Veritas and Mr. Ajaykumar, senior manager, Abbott India. Rev. Fr. Anto Challiserry, Asst. Director welcomed the gathering and Dr. Prema Antony HOD, Anaesthesia proposed vote of thanks. Rev. Fr. Varghese Pallatty, Asst. Director, Sr. Elsy Nursing Administrator, Dr. Rohitha, Head-Microbiology, Sr. Emerit, O.T, in charge, Mr. Sinto, OT - Co-ordinator also attended. Accreditation from the foundation is offered after the institution adopts guidelines and protocols set in this regard. In order to restrict environment degradation and ensure minimal surgery related complications, an audit is then conducted that focuses on five elements - the hospital's commitment towards optimum patient and environment friendly OT designs, pre-operative activities, during operations and post operative activities as well as training and awareness among hospital staff. This certification requires a collaborative effort from various de-



partments of the hospital including quality, infection control, biomedical, anaesthesia etc. The accreditation process brings predictability to service standards as certification is a reassurance for patients regarding safe and healthy practices being followed inside operating rooms. Green, from an operation theatre (OT) perspective covers all parameters like air flows, OT set up, anaesthesia machines, types of volatile agents used, filling-systems adopted and scavenging systems in place. Green connotes cleaner techniques using modern technology and processes with a sensitive approach to environment.

The Green OT certification assures that all patients undergo the standardized protocols of safe anaesthesia administration. Some other key measures include, controlling the temperature, humidity laminar flow, air circulation etc, inside the OTs which are directly related to infection prevention. As a part of the process, Bureau Veritas conducted independent assessments/audits of the hospital and scrutinized the prevention of surgical site infections, safe anaesthesia, surgical teams and equipments. Accreditation forms the foundation for assuring patients that safety and quality standards are being met by the hospital. Patients who seek medical treatment are mostly concerned with the quality and safety aspects of treatment and now prefer to go to the health care providers that are accredited by a recognized National or International Organizations.

Coronary Angiogram is a procedure which is done to find out whether there are blocks in the blood vessels which carry blood to the heart muscles. Usually it is done as an inpatient procedure in the hospital. Radial Lounge is a new concept which is already in practice in western countries where patients who need angiogram will come to the radial lounge on the day of the procedure and will be discharged on the same day after the procedure. A state of the art Radial Lounge is now available in Lisie Hospital which is at par with the western standard. This Radial lounge is attached to the cathlab complex with three cathlabs. Dr Rony Mathew HOD Cardiology

said that The Daycare Angiogram procedure utilizing the radial lounge will be a great help to the patients in terms of time and money.

Lisie Institute of Radiology Research and Imaging Sciences along with Medical Social Work Department

celebrated International Day of Radiology on the 8th of November 2016 at the Reception area of Lisie Hospital. The day marked the 121st Anniversary of the discovery of X-ray by German Physicist Wilhelm Conrad Roentgen. The celebrations commemorate tremendous advances in modern healthcare made possible by Medical Imaging exams – such as X-rays, Computed Tomography (CT) Ultrasound and Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) – and innovations in Radiology Research. Breast Imaging, the theme for this year recognizes the role of imaging in the detection, diagnosis and management of diseases of the breast. Director Rev. Fr.Thomas Vaikathuparambil inaugurated the celebrations and emphasized the key role of Radiology in diagnosis and patient management. He was also in appreciation of the smooth functioning and sincere efforts of the Department of Radiology. Dr. Amy D'Souza, (Senior Consultant & HOD Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology) highlighted the importance of screening mammography. Asst. Director Rev. Fr. Varghese Palatty spoke on the need for co-operation and collaboration between various Clinical Departments & Radiology for accurate diagnosis and early initiation of treatment. Dr. Amel Antony (Sr.Consultant & HOD, Department of Radiology) in his keynote address traced the evolution of breast imaging from X-rays to Digital Mammography. Further he elaborated on the advantages of annual screening mammography starting at age forty which has proved to reduce breast cancer mortality by 30%.

Mrs. Sini Jose welcomed the gathering and Mrs. Milna Simethy proposed the vote of thanks. The celebrations were marked by enthusiastic participation of the audience and the excellent arrangements under the leadership of Rev. Sr. Pavana SABS.



PAEDIATRIC CARDIOLOGY DEPARTMENT ACHIEVEMENTS

In October 2016, we conducted a CME program in association with Jubilee Mission Hospital at Trichur. We also had the privilege to air live cases along with



The division of pediatric cardiology and pediatric cardic surgery at Lisie Heart Institute was established in June 2016. In this period of one year we have established a mature cardiac programme catering to all varieties of heart diseases and have achieved results at par with any leading paediatric cardiac centre in the world. This was possible only with the support of the visionary management of Lisie Hospital and magnanimous philanthropists and the trust placed in us by paediatricians and neonatologists of the state.

Pediatric cardiac surgery in the modern era has become extremely safe and the current focus is to restore the circulation to a normal state at the earliest opportunity. This is our core philosophy that ensures excellent long term survival and better quality of life for children with heart disease. We could recently perform surgery (PDA ligation) on a 600-gram premie that would be the smallest reported case in Kerala. Forty percent of our operated cases were less than 5 Kg and our mortality rate of 1.8% is comparable to any other tertiary centre in the world. our adult colleagues for the Cardiological society of India, in Dec 2016.

Installation of the new cardiac MRI software this year has helped us in better assessment of some complex heart diseases. New operation theatre and ICU complex with all latest facilities has also been a major help.

We have been able to offer free cardiac interventions and

surgery for nearly 100 deserving children with congenital heart disease from all over the world in collaboration with Dr. Varghese Moolan Foundation. These included three children from Liberia, 13 from Manipur and rest from Kerala and Tamil Nadu.

With an aim to extend our services to the needy and under privileged regions, we have conducted free medical camps for diagnosis and management of children with congenital heart disease. These include two camps conducted in North-East India where hundreds of children were screened for heart diseases and those who required interventions were treated at our hospital free of cost. Similar camps were also conducted at other places like Kottiyam, Tanur, Cheruplassery and Perinthalmanna.

Our plan in the next few years is to create a spoke and hub model for other centres all over the country from wherein we could guide them manage cases locally as well as be the tertiary referral centre for more complex cases . ECHOLIS

World Diabetes Day 14th November 2016

World Diabetes Day is the primary global awareness campaign focusing on diabetes mellitus and is held on November 14 each year. As part of the Health Day celebration we the Medical Social Work department along with the 4th year BSc nursing students organized an awareness programme at the reception. Dr. Betsy Annie Koshi was the Chief Guest of the Day. One in two adults with diabetes is undiagnosed. Many people live with type 2 diabetes for a long period of time without being aware of their condition. By the time of diagnosis, diabetes complications may already be present. Up to 70% of type 2 diabetes cases can be prevented or delayed by adopting healthier lifestyles. With increasing levels of poor nutrition and physical inactivity among children in many countries, type 2 diabetes in childhood has the potential to become a global public health issue leading to serious health outcomes. Topics included were diabetes and human rights, diabetes and lifestyle, diabetes and obesity, and diabetes in children and adolescents. The theme of the day was 'Eyes on Diabetes'. Students arranged puppet show based on the theme.

ACHIEVEMENTS OF GENERAL SURGERY

EYES ON DIABETES

General Surgery department is one of the biggest departments in Lisie Hospital with eminent consultants. Dr. Joy Mampilly as HOD of unit –I and Dr. Paulose Jacob is the Senior Consultant. Dr. Ananthapadmanabhan as HOD of Unit-II. Department works round the clock, serving emergency and elective surgeries.

Almost 750 Thyroidectomy and 6000 major and minor cases were performed in 2016, which included large intrathoracic goiter reaching up to arch of Aorta, young girl with large carotid body tumour, very large retroperitoneal sarcoma excision, unresectable neuroblastoma excision which was not taken up by any other reputed hospital, large retro sternal goiter of one kg weight, all kind of emergency and elective laparotomies etc.

Under the guidance and dedication of experienced doctors and staff general surgery department is going successfully.

Hemodialysis Centre

Dialysis is a treatment that does some of the things done by healthy kidneys...

ECHOLIS

Lisie hospital dialysis centre was started on 19th April 1994. The centre started with a few dialysis machines and gradually increased in size owing to the needs of renal failure patients. The blessing of 'Msgr. Parackal Memorial Dialysis Centre' was done by Rt. Rev. Mar Sebastian Adayanthrath on 8th March 2015. It is situated on the ground floor of St. Antony's Surgical Block. Currently the centre has 33 hemodialysis machines and one CRRT machine. There are two separate areas of dialysis, HD centre 1 and HD centre 2. All virology negative patients are taken in HD centre 1 and hepatitis B & C positive patients are taken in HD centre 2. Emergency and priority cases are preferred.

Other than hemodialysis, routine procedures are also performed like plasmaphersis, CRRT (Continous Renal Replacement Therapy), Centerline insertion, phlebotomy, ascitic tapping etc. in our centre. If any complication arises during dialysis we provide emergency management for the patient and will be shifted to HDICU. Other than HD Centre 1& 2, we have the machine service room, solution preparation area, Staff's changing rooms, isolation room, class rrom for dialysis technician students and doctors room. Doctors are available round the clock.

Functioning of Dialysis Centre

From every Monday to Saturday we have routine dialysis and associated duties and responsibilities. On Sunday entire unit is cleaned and disinfected. If necessary as per doctor's order dialysis of IP patients and ICU patients are done. In addition maintenance of water treatment also is done.

A co-operative and collaborative work of the Sr. In charge, Sr Pear CSC, all nursing staff, dialysis technician

staffs, students, ANM staffs and house keeping staffs are the secret of proper functioning of dialysis centre. About 70–80 hemodialysis cases are performed on each day.

By the result of our co-ordinated work, we got an award of best department of Lisie hospital for the month of May 2017. And the best in-charge was Sr. Pear CSC, the Sister In-charge of dialysis centre.
